Puerto Vallarta, Mexico - A quintessential Mexican resort renowned for its cobbled streets, red-tiled roofs, beautiful bay and the luxurious villas of Gringo Gulch

Puerto Quetzal, Guatemala - Colonial Antigua (a UNESCO World Heritage site), Lake Atitlan, where modern Maya still weave their stories on backstrap looms and Tikal (also a UNESCO World Heritage site) where a secretive jungle plaza is flanked by seven great stone temples.

Corinto, Nicaragua - Pristine beaches, lush mangrove forests and magnificent volcanoes - take a stroll along the Costa Azul for a view of the bay and the islands, explore the ruins of Leon Viejo, excavated from centuries of volcanic debris (UNESCO World Heritage site)

Fuerte Amador, Panama City, Panama - Time to catch all the excitement and energy as your ship over-nights in this teeming city

Cartagena, Colombia - Colonial architecture, pristine offshore islands, historic Spanish Main plus the finest emeralds in the world - a UNESCO World Heritage site (Port and Fortresses)
